## 2017-2018 Dress Code

All students in kindergarten through grade 5 are required to wear a school uniform at all times while attending school or any school-sponsored activity **during** the school day.

### **Basic Uniforms**

#### **Bottoms: Navy, Black or Khaki/Tan**

Walking Shorts, Slacks, Skirts, Skirted jumpers  
Must be plain, solid-color Twill, Corduroy or Denim fabric

#### **Tops: Red, White or Navy with collar**

Must have long or short sleeves  
Knit polo-type, Oxford or woven dress shirts, blouses, turtlenecks  
School t-shirts are okay (available through our school office)

### **Alternatives and Other dress code rules:**

- The principal may designate collared shirts with a school logo; school sponsored T-shirts with a crew neck; and dress out of basic uniform on designated days.
- A belt is required if the garment has belt loops.
- Shirts (including t-shirts) must be tucked in.
- Shorts/skirts must be mid-thigh or longer.
- Shoes must be safe and appropriate.
- "Flip-Flop" type shoes are not permitted.
- Shoes must have a back heel strap.
- The use of shoes with wheels is not permitted on campus.
- Clothes must be appropriate size, with waist of garment worn at the student's waist.
- Clothing that is too tight or too loose is not appropriate for school.
- Solid red, navy, or white hoodie, sweatshirt, sweater, or jacket with or without school logo is the only outerwear allowed to be worn during class.
- Red, navy, or white long sleeve shirts or turtlenecks may be worn under a school logo shirt.
- The Dress Code does not allow for clothing with colored trim, stripes, embroidery, decoration, etc. It also does not provide for overalls (overalls with pants or shorts), sweat pants, knit pants/skirts, leggings, etc. A small logo is acceptable.
- School administrators will determine if clothing is appropriate for school.
