If you see a notation by your child's teacher's name that he/she is teaching out-of-field, be assured that Florida law requires him/her to be working toward in-field certification and the district monitors progress toward compliance. Teachers marked out-of-field in academic areas are working toward certification in the subject area being taught. Teachers marked out-of-field in ESOL are working toward a special endorsement (English to Speakers of Other Languages) that is required to teach Limited English Proficient students.
